**1. An individual or group of individuals**

- ✓ Based on service as a volunteer
- ✓ Made a substantial contribution to improving the quality of life in Kenmore

**2. A member of an Commission or Committee**

- ✓ Been a member of the commission or committee for at least two years
- ✓ Made a substantial contribution to the work of the commission or committee

**3. A Public Employee**

- ✓ Employee of publicly supported organization within Kenmore
- ✓ Consistently demonstrated exceptional ability to work effectively with the public
- ✓ Made exceptional and significant contribution to improving the quality of life in Kenmore

**4. A Business, Agency or Organization**

- ✓ Located in Kenmore
- ✓ Demonstrated exceptional leadership in improving the quality of life of the community
